Maak Foundation is committed to supporting and promoting studio ceramics. By providing funding for research and projects that result in the publication of books and literary material dedicated to studio ceramics the purpose is to advance the education and understanding of studio ceramics for the wider public.

Funding is available to individuals and organisations through grants with applications open for submission two times per year.

Our funding priorities are:

- Funding research into important individual ceramic artists, groups of ceramic artists or broader artistic developments in studio ceramics for subsequent publication.
- Funding research for written material to support non-commercial exhibitions of studio ceramics intended to provide educational opportunities to the general public.

We would not normally support any commercial exhibition or event where works are offered for sale.
